# Application Information for International Degree Students

---



## Procedures:

1. Make sure you are qualified to apply as an international student. (See next section.)
2. Check whether the department/institute for which you intend to apply accept international students.
3. Fill out the application form online (<http://www.ia.nctu.edu.tw> > Prospective Students > Admissions > Online Application), submit the information and print out all required forms.
4. Check whether you need to submit additional documents for the department/institute to which you intend to apply.
5. Prepare all required documents accordingly and confirm all required signatures.
6. Plan your schedule to allow enough time for your package to arrive at the Office of International Affairs (OIA) by the specified deadline either by hand delivery or post. Late submission and incomplete application packages will not be processed.

## Note:

- No application documents will be returned, whether the applicant is admitted or not.
- It is the applicants' responsibility should the admission result be affected by not submitting the required documents as specified.
- Admission to NCTU does not guarantee the issuance of a VISA for Taiwan, Republic of China (ROC).

## Qualification

Applicants seeking degree program admissions must meet the legal qualification standard as stated in the "Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan" released by the Ministry of Education (MOE) on February 1, 2011:

Failure to meet the above regulation may result in serious consequences, including cancelation/revocation of admission offer, student status or diploma. Violators will not receive any academic documents.

# General Required Documents



Applicants may apply up to 3 programs. A complete set of application documents should be prepared for each program applied.

## 1. Application Checklist

The checklist is printable from the online application system.

## 2. Admission Application Form

Fill out the online application form, print and sign it.

## 3. One study plan

The study plan can be written in English or Chinese.

## 4. One photocopy of official diploma\*

The official diploma must bear the seal of the issuing institution.

Application to Bachelor's degree program: Senior high school diploma

Application to Master's degree program: Bachelor's degree diploma

Application to Doctoral degree program: Master's degree diploma

Graduating student should submit a certificate issued by the school/university for the forth-coming graduation. The official diploma should be notarized by the Taiwan Embassy or Taiwan Representative Office nearby and submitted upon registration at NCTU.

### 4a. Translation of official diploma (if applicable)\*

The official diploma must be translated into either English or Chinese when the original one is not issued in either language.

## 5. One copy of official transcript\*

The official transcript must bear the seal of the issuing institution. If you have attended more than one institution, separate official transcripts should be submitted by each institution.

Application to Bachelor's degree program: Senior high school transcript

Application to Master's degree program: Bachelor's degree transcript

Application to Doctoral degree program: Master's degree transcript

It should be sealed and sent by the issuing institution to the International Admissions Office of OIA directly. Alternatively, submit the copy of transcript notarized by the Taiwan Embassy.

### 5a. Translation of official transcript (if applicable)\*

The official transcript must be translated into either English or Chinese when the original one is not issued in either language.

\*Foreign diploma, transcript and their translation should be notarized by the overseas Taiwan Embassy/Representative Office. If applicants are not able to obtain the notarized copy before the deadline of admission application, they may choose to submit the copy of diploma and transcript without notarization by the Taiwan Embassy. However, the admission review committee reserves the right to decide whether to consider un-notarized documents or not. All notarized copy should be submitted if offered admission. ## 6. Two letters of recommendation

The letters of recommendation must be written by the applicant's teachers/advisors/employers in either English or Chinese and submitted in sealed and signed envelopes.

## 7. One photocopy of passport

One photocopy of the photo page is required.

## 8. Confidential Financial Statement

The applicant must show documented evidence that sufficient funds to cover all tuition, fees, transportation, and living expenses are available for the first year of their studies at NCTU, by one of the following means:

- A photocopy of scholarship award notification and a signed "Statement of Understanding"
- An official bank statement issued in English/Chinese (dated after August 1st, 2011) in the amount of USD 6,000 (NTD 200,000) or above and a signed "Statement of Understanding". In the case the bank statement is not issued in the name of the applicant, a signed declaration must be provided from the sponsor. In the declaration it should clearly states the sponsor's relationship with the applicant and commitment to cover the applicant's all expenses in Taiwan.

Be aware that all fees and expenses vary per person and subject to change.

## 9. Medical report

The complete medical report should include the HIV/AIDS screening result and should be issued within the last 6 months. The report should be signed by a practicing physician and stamped by the hospital/clinic.

## 10. One photo copy of the proof of English proficiency

One photo copy of the test score is required. The minimum requirements (or equivalent) are **TOEFL PBT 500 / CBT 173 / iBT 73, IELTS 5.5 or TOEIC 650** unless specified otherwise by the department/institute.

## 11. Proof of Chinese proficiency

This documents is required for undergraduate programs; for graduate program, it is subject to each institute's admission regulation. Chinese proficiency may be evaluated by letters written by Chinese instructors, certificates, or photocopy of test score. **TOCFL** (Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language) test result is preferred.

## 12. Proof of work experiences (if applicable)

It is required for application to the GMBA program.

## 13. Proof of renouncement of nationality of the Republic of China(if applicable)

The document should be issued by the Ministry of Interior for more than 8 years to the registration date of intended term of entry.

## 14. Other documents

Documents such as GMAT/GRE scores or proof of work experience may be required by specific department/institute. For specific requirements, please visit the website of individual department/institute.

# Support for International Students



**The Office of International Affairs (OIA)** is responsible for international admissions, as well as academic exchange with prominent academic and research institutes worldwide.

There are several organizations under the direction of the OIA:

**The International Service Center (ISC)** assists international students with all aspects of their stay at NCTU. The ISC organizes cultural activities to help students adapt to the local lifestyle and cultivate mutual understanding among international students and local students.

**The Foreign Students Association (FSA)** is a legal organization representing international students at NCTU. The FSA creates a platform for aiding international students in their integration into the campus community and assisting prospective students from around the world.



**The Student Ambassadors Association (SAA)** is composed of local students who are interested in other cultures and enthusiastic about helping international students to adjust to the local environment and providing assistance with events organization, including promoting NCTU to the international community.

In addition, the FSA and the SAA work closely with the ISC to plan various activities: parties, trips around Taiwan, international cultural presentations, food fairs and much more.

# Life in Hsinchu

Hsinchu lies approximately 80 km south of Taipei, the capital of Taiwan. Also known as the Windy City, Hsinchu is the heart of the high-tech industry in Taiwan and home to the Hsinchu Science Park.

Other than cultural and sporting events in NCTU, there are many things to do in Hsinchu, including paying a visit to the Glass Museum, the Hsinchu Zoo, or the historic East Gate. Nature lovers can easily go for a hike in the nearby hills and mountains or go to the seaside for delicious seafood, bird-watching, and a bike ride along the famous 17km scenic route. Events and celebrations are hosted year-around, including the International Rice Noodle and Meatball Festival. For shopping, there are several large department stores and a number of local shops and markets.

Hsinchu, by day or night, is animated and energetic – the perfect place for students to pursue their studies and experience local culture.

Selected students may be awarded a monthly stipend and/or exemption from tuition fees.</p> <p><b>A. Amount:</b></p> <p>(1) Undergraduate students: up to NT\$7,000 per month and/or waiver of tuition and fees.  (2) Masters students: up to NT\$10,000 per month and/or waiver/reduction of tuition and fees.  (3) Doctoral students: up to NT\$15,000 per month and/or waiver/reduction of tuition and fees.</p> <p><b>C. Duration:</b> 6 months in the first semester (6-12 months thereafter).</p> <p><b>D. Renewal:</b> At the end of the first semester, students may apply for NCTU International Scholarships for outstanding current students which offer monthly stipends (up to NT\$10,000/13,000/20,000 for bachelors/masters/doctoral students) and/or waiver/reduction of tuition and fees.
