

Regulations of “Field Completion Certificate” for Undergraduate Students

Revised in May, 2012

A Student who has taken at least 6 credits in one field, and who has passed (in the same field) two courses with an average score of at least 70, can submit an application for a “Field Completion Certificate” to the Department office. The certificate will be granted to the student, after the Department course committee inspects and approves the student’s application. A student may apply for certificates for more than one field. In order to apply for the certificate with respect to each field, please submit the application form and your transcript to the Department within the first month of each semester. A student may use this certificate as a reference document in perusing higher academic degrees or in seeking positions in the job market.
